GENERAL INFORMATION

Enrollment is open to all children four years old by September 1, 2018. Please register for camps according to the grade your child will enter in the fall of 2018.

Children who are enrolled for full-day camps or for both morning and afternoon camps will need to bring a sack lunch (unless on a camp field trip). Campers will have a supervised lunch and recess period from 12:00 pm to 1:00 pm.

Please be mindful that Summer at St. John's is a nut-sensitive camp program. All snacks provided by the camp are nut-free and campers staying for lunch may not bring any food containing peanuts or tree nuts.

Before and after camp care is available to accommodate busy summer schedules. Full week before/after care is available for sign-up during the online registration process. Before and after camp care is also available as a drop-in for \$10 per care session. This may be arranged by emailing summer@stjohnsschool.org or calling the summer office at 214.328.9131 x116.

Summer at St. John's reserves the right to limit camp enrollment size and/or cancel camps if minimum enrollment is not met. Reimbursement for cancelled camps will be paid in full.

If you find it necessary to cancel your child's camp registration, refunds will be provided according to the following procedure:

- A full refund, less administrative processing fee of \$50, will be provided if cancellation occurs prior to two weeks in advance of the commencement of the camp session.
- Fifty percent of the camp fee will be refunded if requested in writing prior to one week before the commencement of the camp session.
- No refund will be made within one week of the commencement of the camp session.




