Dear Tuition Assistance Applicant,

This letter outlines the tuition assistance application procedures for the 2021-22 academic year. To ensure confidentiality and awards based on complete financial information, St. John's relies on a third-party professional corporation, **FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment**, to accept and process tuition assistance applications. The recommendations from **FACTS** provide the St. John's Tuition Assistance Committee with a guideline upon which to base its awards.

## NEW 2020-21 STUDENTS - APPLICATION DEADLINE FEBRUARY 1, 2021

Tuition assistance awards will be included with the offer of enrollment for the 2021-22 school year. If you are applying for tuition assistance for a new student, the application process must be completed by **February 1, 2021** or the application may not be considered. Admission acceptance for new students is "need-blind;" acceptance to St. John's is based solely on the student's ability to be successful in the school environment, not the family's ability to afford the entire tuition. Late tuition assistance applications will be considered, only if funds are still available. Admission and Tuition Assistance award letters for families new to St. John's will be sent with your acceptance letter and contract on **Friday, March 12, 2021**.

- New users select *Create an Account OR Returning Users* enter your existing Username and Password. It is not necessary to complete the entire application at one time. You may access your worksheet as often as necessary.

- Note that if you are separated or divorced, the non-custodial parent must also complete an online application.
